## FIRST STARS PROGRAM

**Player Assist Program**  
Players can borrow set of hockey equipment for the year, based on availability. Deposit \$75, refundable on return at year end

- U9 and below (born 2013-2017) who are new to hockey
- October - March for 20 weeks total, 1 session/week, 50 minutes on a consistent day and time
- Focus on skating and teaching of introductory hockey skills
- There are no games against other teams, it is solely a Twin Centre introductory program

**Cost:** \$225

## U7 TIMBITS PROGRAM

**Player Assist Program**  
Players can borrow set of hockey equipment for the year, based on availability. Deposit \$75, refundable on return at year end

- U7 and below (born 2015-2017), players grouped by skill
- October - March, 2-3 sessions/week, 40-50 mins/session
- Focus on introductory hockey fundamentals (skating, puck handling, passing, shooting)
- 8 - 12 cross ice exhibition games, 1-2 Jamborees\*

**Cost:** \$485 + \$150 fundraising fee



# TWIN CENTRE

## U8/U9 PROGRAMS

**Player Assist Program**  
Players can borrow set of hockey equipment for the year, based on availability. Deposit \$75, refundable on return at year end

- Players born 2014 (U8); 2013 (U9), players tiered by skill (REP/MD, LL)
- October - March, 2-3 sessions/week, 50-60 mins/session,
- Focus on age appropriate hockey fundamentals (skating, puck handling, passing, shooting)
- U8 (½ ice); U9 (½ ice and full ice), \*30-40 games (exhibition, league, jamboree, tournament)

**Cost:** \$630 + \$150 fundraising fee

\* Games and tournaments are dependent on provincial reopening plan/stage
